Haggai 2:3-9 - September 10, 2017

1. Be strong and work. (vs. 4)

Be strong ... now get to work, for I am with you.” Judah’s people had returned to worshipping God, and God had promised to bless their efforts. But it was time for them to work. We must be people of prayer, Bible study, and worship, but eventually we must get out and do the work God has prepared for us. He wants to change the world through us, his ambassadors. God has given you a job to do in the church, at your place of employment, and at home. The time has come to take courage and get going because God is with you!

2. Since His Spirit is with us, there’s nothing to fear. (vs. 5)

(Joshua 1:9) (2 Timothy 1:7)

3. Remember the Lord said “He will shake ALL things before He fills His house with Glory!” (vs. 6-7)

(Acts 16:25-26)

People want the glory without the shaking.
Everything in place doesn’t deserve the glory.
The shaking is necessary.

4. To keep your peace, remember that everything belongs to God. (vs. 8-9)
